System eliminates airport hassles

Toiletries - Say goodbye to carry-on confusion, thanks to a new toiletry bag that's been cleared for takeoff by the Transportation Security Administration (TSA).

Designed by 3-1-1 Travel Bag, the Clear Bag System is a practical, yet stylish answer to today's airport security restrictions, which regulate liquids and gels in carry-on luggage. Under TSA regulations, air travellers are only permitted to carry on liquids, gels and aerosols in containers weighing 85 grams or less; these must then be enclosed in a clear, litre-sized zip-top baggie.

The Clear Bag System is a TSA-compliant alternative designed to be reused every time you board a plane. The 15-x-20-centimetre system fits inside carry-on luggage and includes five reusable containers, eliminating the need to purchase multiple travel-sized products and making the bag both economical and environmentally friendly.

The containers come with airless pumps that dispense shampoo, lotion and other toiletries.
